Kindly sanction the first and second year students to participate in Thalassemia Rally organized by Arpan Blood Bank on 8th September 2012.





Subject: Request to participate in 'Thalassemia awareness rally' organized on 8th Sept. 2012.

R/Sir,

Firstly, I extend my gratitude for your help to Arpan blood bank in 'Saving Life' of thousands of patients by way of organizing voluntary blood donation camps at your esteem institute.

I take this opportunity to share with you about latest developments at Arpan.

Arpan blood bank received 'NABH accreditation' in Dec. 2010 & is the third large sized blood bank across country to have this honor. Arpan blood bank established 'NAT laboratory' in March 2011 to provide safest blood to patients to avoid serious hazards of blood transfusion. Arpan blood bank is the first standalone blood bank across country to establish 'NAT testing facility. Arpan blood bank received the State level award of 'highest voluntary blood collection' in the year 2011 by the hands of Hon. Health Minister of Maharashtra State- Mr. Suresh Shetty and Arpan could achieve this only because of organizers of voluntary blood donation camps like you. Thank you once again. At present Arpan run 10 blood banks across state, managing almost 7% blood requirement of the State & serving the society 24/7.

With our 16 years of work in blood banking domain, we have identified 'Thalassemia' as one area which is critical but neglected domain of public health.

Thalassemia is a inherited blood disorder characterized by anemia (low hemoglobin) of various severity. There are two types of Thalassemia- Major & Minor. Thalassemia minor patients suffer mild anemia & usually live normal life. But they are the carriers of abnormal genes of hemoglobin synthesis. When two Thalassemia minor patients marry, they have 25% chance during each pregnancy of having Thalassemia major child. Children born with Thalassemia major disease suffer with severe anemia & get diagnosed in few months of life, due to ailments of the disease. Since, then they need regular blood transfusion every month to survive. They suffer various complications of the disease & usually succumb to them in 2nd or 3rd decade of life, through taking regular blood transfusion. At present, there are 120 thalassemic major patients in Nashik region.

Arpan realized that, if we provide better management to these children, they may have long & safe life like us. Arpan took lead role in forming Arpan Thalassemia Society- a trust comprising of blood bankers, doctors, patrons & parents of Thalassemia patients. To provide comprehensive management to these patients, Arpan has established Thalassemia care centre at Savita Desai Hospital, IMA, Shalimar with the help of IMA Nashik, Nashik run charitable trust & Jain social group. At present, 108 thalassemic children are registered with the centre availing best possible treatment of the disease by experts in the field, totally free of cost.
